








Early Career Framework (ECF)

From September 2021, the Early Career Framework (ECF) reforms will entitle all early career teachers to a fully-funded, two-year package of structured training and support linked to the best available research evidence.



Coupled with the ITT Core Content Framework, the ECF will establish an entitlement to a three-year structured and evidence-informed package of support for all new teachers at the start of their careers.

Induction for Early Career Teachers



All qualified teachers who are employed in a relevant school in England must, by law, have completed an induction period satisfactorily

- From September 2021 the induction period will be for 2 years.
- Early Career Framework based training is expected to be embedded as a central aspect of induction. There are 5 key areas - Behaviour management/ Pedagogy/ Curriculum/ Assessment/ Professional behaviours
- The Teachers' Standards will be used to assess an early career teacher's performance at the end of their induction period


DfE Manage training for early career teachers service

- Induction tutor to provide:
 - Name, email, induction start date, Teacher Reference Number (TRN), date-of-birth.
- TRN and DoB can be supplied directly by the ECT or mentor if needed
- Later in the summer term, we will ask schools to identify which appropriate body they have appointed so we can confirm this with the appropriate body

When ECTs move schools...

- When an ECT or mentor has started training at another school and is going to be joining your school, an induction tutor can now administer most transfers themselves directly within DfE's Manage training for early career teachers service
- You will need to provide their:
 - Name
 - Email
 - TRN
 - Date-of-birth
 - National Insurance number (optional)
- You will still need to notify your appropriate body
